We ask three things: that you have a **need** (and this means different things to different people, each situation is assessed separately), that you are **able to pay** (you must have an income of some sort to pay the mortgage and your bills) and most importantly, your family must be **willing to partner** with us (this means everything from building your home to attending educational classes and children studying and getting good grades).
