ORDINANCE 2008-07

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-10
REGARDING THE COLLECTION STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
OF TRASH AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS TO PROHIBIT
THE BURNING OF ALL TRASH AND RECYCLABLE
MATERIALS.**

AND NOW, this 28th day of October, 2008, it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of East Fallowfield Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby amends Section 2.F of Ordinance No. 95-10 to replace the term “Recyclable Trash” with the term “Recyclable” defined as follows:

Recyclable: Any items or materials that are required to be recycled in East Fallowfield Township under Pennsylvania Act 101, the Pennsylvania Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, 1988, July 28, P.L. 556, No. 101, including paper, newspaper, tin and aluminum cans and containers, glass of any color, plastics, leaf waste, and any other material as designated by the Township;

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby amends Ordinance No. 95-10 to replace any reference to the term “Recyclable Trash” with the term “Recyclable”.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby amends Section 6 of Ordinance No. 95-10 to include the following additional language:

It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to be burned upon any land in East Fallowfield Township any Recyclable, Trash, Hazardous Trash, Residual Trash, food waste, vehicle wastes, large household appliances, construction or demolition waste, cleaners, solvents, paint, motor oil, fuels, gasoline and any other similar product.

Section 4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
