PEDDLERS

The Township of East Fallowfield Township hereby ordains:

§101. Definitions.

- (a) The word “peddling” as used in this Ordinance shall mean engaging in peddling, canvassing, soliciting or taking of orders, either by sample or otherwise, for any goods, wares, or merchandise, upon any of the streets, sidewalks or from house to house within the Township of East Fallowfield, PROVIDED: the word peddling shall not apply (1) to farmers selling their own produce, (2) to the sale of goods, wares and merchandise, donated by the owners thereof, the proceeds whereof are to be applied to any charitable or philanthropic purpose, or (3) to any manufacturer or producer in the sale of bread and bakery products, meat or meat products, milk or milk products.
- (b) The word “peddler” as used in this Ordinance, shall mean any person who shall engage in peddling, as hereinabove defined.
- (c) The word “Person” as used in this Ordinance, shall mean any natural person, association, partnership, firm or cooperation.
- (d) In this Ordinance, the singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

§ 102. License Required.

No person shall engage in peddling in the Township of East Fallowfield without first having taken out a license as herein provided.

§ 103. Application for License; Individual Licenses Required for Each Helper; Licenses Non-Transferrable.

Every person desiring to engage in peddling in the Township of East Fallowfield, shall first make the application to the Secretary’s deputy or deputies appointed for this purpose, for a license. Upon such application such person shall give his name; permanent address at which he will receive notices under this Ordinance; address; his previous criminal record; excepting minor traffic offenses, if any; the name of the person for whom he works, if any; the type of goods, wares, or merchandise he wishes to peddle; the length of time for he wishes to be licensed; the type of vehicle he uses, if any; and the number of helpers he has. PROVIDED when a person makes application for himself and one or more helpers, all applicable personal information specified above shall be given for each helper, and an individual license shall be required for each helper. No license issued under this Ordinance shall be transferrable from one person to another.

§ 104. Fees.

No license shall be issued under this Ordinance until the proper fee, as follows shall be paid the Secretary or his deputy, which shall be for the use of the Township: All peddlers, \$5 per day; \$10 per week; \$30 per month; \$150 per year.

§ 105. Issuance of License; Information Thereon.

Upon making application thereof and paying the proper fee as herein specified, a license shall be issued to every peddler, provided that the Township Secretary may refuse to issue a license if he has reasonable grounds for believing the applicant to be of poor moral character, and the applicant shall be required to apply in person to the board of Supervisors. Such license shall contain the information required when engaged in peddling in the Township, carry such license upon his person, and shall exhibit such license upon request, to all police officers, township officials and citizens. No peddler shall engage in selling any produce as mentioned in this license.

§ 106. Sunday Sales Prohibited; Hours of Sale Restricted.

No person licensed as a peddler under this Ordinance shall engage in peddling at any time on Sunday, or upon any other day of the week before nine o'clock, a.m., or after five o'clock, pm.

§ 107. Noise Restrictions; Entry of Premises Without Permission Prohibited.

No person, licensed as a peddler under this Ordinance shall hawk or cry his wares upon any of the streets or sidewalks of the Township, nor shall he use any loud speaker or horn or any other device for announcing his presence by which the public is annoyed. No person licensed as a peddler under this Ordinance shall enter, or attempt to enter, any dwelling house without invitation or permission of the occupant and shall immediately leave any premises upon request.

§ 108. Maintenance of Fixed Location is Prohibited.

No person licensed as a peddler under this Ordinance, shall occupy any fixed location upon the streets or sidewalks of the Township for the purpose of peddling, with or without any stand or counter.

§ 109. Suspension of License; Notice.

The Township Secretary is hereby authorized and empowered to suspend any license issued under this Ordinance, when he deems, from information received, such suspension to be beneficial to the public health, safety or morals, or for violations of any provisions of this Ordinance, or for giving false information on the application for a license thereunder. Notice of such suspension shall be given by written notice personally served or sent by registered mail to the address shown on the application. The holder of the suspended license shall immediately surrender his license to the Township Secretary.

§ 110. Violations and Penalties.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, before any magistrate of the Township of East Fallowfield, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment in the County Prison for not more than thirty (30) days.

§ 111. Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any provisions thereof shall be held to be unconstitutional, invalid or illegal, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional, invalid or illegal provisions not been included herein.
