Contacted resident who stated fire had been put out earlier and was not the source of the smoke. Ask resident for burning permit, as this is a repeat occurrence at this location. They were unable to provide a permit. Sta 37 on location and extinguished fire. Investigation reveled cardboard and debris was being burned. Attempted to speak with resident again, but they would not come to door. Follow up letter will be mailed to property owners advising future violations will result in issuance of citation.
