ORDINANCE NO. 2010-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, PART 4 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST FALLOWFIELD CODE OF ORDINANCES, GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS, BY REVISING THE PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS. EFFECTIVE FIVE DAYS FROM ENACTMENT.

AND NOW, this <u>21</u> day of <u>Occurrence</u>, 2010, the Board of Supervisors of East Fallowfield Township hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 15, Part 4, §15-408, is hereby amended read as follows:

§15-408. Penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of this Part, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25 and costs. Provided, it shall be the duty of the police officers and of parking enforcement personnel of the Township to report to the appropriate official all violations of any provision of this Part indicating, in each case, the Section violated; the license number of the vehicle involved in the violation; the location where the violation took place; and any other facts that might be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending the violation. The police officer or other person making the report shall also attach to or place upon every such vehicle a notice stating that the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part. The notice shall contain instructions to the owner or driver of the vehicle that if he will pay the sum of \$25 by check or money order mailed to the Township with payment received by the Township within 14 days after the time of the notice, that act will save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs prescribed in the first sentence of this Section.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
