  - a. Peoples Hall Class I historic resource and significant local landmark in need of renovation to stop decay of structure from water infiltration. Consideration of permit application for emergency temporary structural and envelope repairs.
    - Pursuant to discussion ands affirmative vote at last meeting, recommendation was made to the Code Enforcement Officer to issue a building permit. Permit was issued and renovation activities continued.
  - **b. 2960 Strasburg Road** renovation of the historic resource and former one-room schoolhouse has been observed, new roof has been placed.
    - Owner to appear before the Commission to review the roof installation pursuant to request by Code Enforcement Officer.
  - c. 30 Loop Road Class I Historic Resource as included in the Township Inventory, listed on the National Register, formerly known as the James Fulton Tenant House. Property recently sold; new owners have undertaken extensive renovations. Owner(s) referred trio Historical Commission by the Code Enforcement Officer to review their renovation plans.
    - Owner to appear before Commission to review renovation plans per request of Code Enforcement Officer.

## V. New Business

- a. 720 South Caln Road Class I Historic Resource included in the Township inventory and the National Register, described as a colonial revival stone/frame house built in 1930, formerly known as the Martin House, and designed by architect R. Brognard Okie.
  - Property offered for sale, prospective buyer interested in discussing what renovations may be made, and what the process is to secure permitting.
